## HYDRODYNAMICS THERAPY INFUSES THE SKIN WITH VITAMINS, ANTI-OXIDANTS

**Medicamat** has launched Aquarejuvenation, a new hydrodynamics-based therapy that is painless and non-invasive for the face and neck. This therapy is designed to infuse the skin with anti-aging vitamins and antioxidants to enhance the radiance of the skin, even out the complexion, decrease fine lines and wrinkles, fade pigmentation, attenuate acne scars, improve firmness and elasticity of the face and neck and redefine the contour of the face.

The treatment involves a three-step process: bio-peeling, detoxification of the skin and infusion of vitamins and antioxidants through high-pressure water microjects.

During the first stage of the process (bio-peeling), an organic powder made of fruits pits exfoliates the skin instead of the traditional aluminum oxide. Next, high-pressure water microjects (220 to 290 psi) penetrate the skin. These microjects not only include water but also vitamin C, minerals and plant extracts that are anti-aging. Lastly, MedicaRejuv, a concentrated anti-aging serum is applied, followed by Medica Derm, a protective and dermis-healing cream. Then Medica Sun, an anti-UV cream for pigmented spots. Medica White, a bleaching serum and an anti-seborrheoa serum for skin that is oily and prone to acne is applied as needed.

After an initial treatment of three to five sessions that are 10 to 15 days apart, one to three sessions of maintenance therapy is recommended.

## FOUR NEW LASERS FROM CANDELA

**Candela Corporation** is launching four new cosmetic lasers at the upcoming American Academy of Dermatology meeting in February. The new lasers include the GentleMax, AlexTriVantage, SmoothPeel and LightStation 100.

**GentleMax.** This laser has the advantage of two wavelength capabilities in a single stand-alone device. The "fully loaded" GentleMax has 1.5 mm to 18 mm spots and blended wavelength technology as well as optional FPL, Erbium and diode units that are intended to be purchased together with the base unit or as a stand-alone device.

**AlexTriVantage.** This laser is the next generation of the AlexLazr. It has additional wavelengths with 532 nm and 1,064 nm handpieces (q-switched), which allows for removal of more tattoo colors and treatment of pigmented lesions.

The q-switch 755 nm ms wavelength will be able to work more efficiently on difficult colors (i.e., green) and a wider range of pigmented lesions.

Lastly, fiber optic delivery provides a more gentle treatment because it has a longer, more even pulse without hotspots.

**SmoothPeel.** This laser is a low-power Erbium/YAG laser and an alternative to a mid-level chemical facial peel/microdermabrasion.

Treatment parameters are determined by SmoothPeel's instrumentation, not the uncertain interaction of chemicals with the patient's skin nor practitioner experience. This laser also is safer to use on thin-skinned areas like the neck and chest, decreasing the risk of side effects.

**LightStation 100.** This laser has a wide range of treatment parameters that provide safe and effective options for the most frequently requested procedures. Treatment parameters include vascular and pigmented lesions, acne and gentle skin rejuvenation by

removing redness and pigmentation.

According to a spokesperson for the company, the GentleMax, AlexTriVantage and LightStation 100 are 510(k) pending with the Food and Drug Administration.
